Subject: Compliance to "Year 2000" (FY2K) requirements.

We have been asked several times, and will be continued to be asked about any effect of the pending "Year 2000" on Dilog/DLI controllers and the equipment on which they are being used.

None of the Dilog/DLI manufactured tape, disk, or communications controllers use, generate, receive or are otherwise affected by date settings of any kind. As a result, the transition of the date from 1999 to 2000 will have no effect on the operation or function of any of these products.

While our controllers are very intelligent within themselves, to the outside world, they appear as "dumb" devices. As such, data containing date and time information may be passed through them on the way to or from a tape, disk, or terminal type device, but is not acted upon by the controller. When being issued commands and instructions or answering requests for status by the controlling computer, date and time is never a part of this communication process. So our controllers are not "date aware" in any manner.

Our customers can be assured and may be confident that there will be absolutely no problems issuing forth as a result of using any of these Dilog/DLI products.
